



Field Set for 2009 Sorenson Champions Challenge

Lehi, UT – *The field is set for the 12th annual Sorenson Champions Challenge at the Thanksgiving Point Golf Club in Lehi, Utah, Oct. 12-13, 2009.*

Utah Jazz point guard Deron Williams will also be playing in the two-day Sorenson Champions Challenge with a NBA star or celebrity playing partner to be announced at a later date.

The public is invited to attend the two-day event which begins with a Pro-Am for sponsors and guests at the Thanksgiving Point Golf Club on Monday, Oct. 12, at 11:00 a.m. The Sorenson Champions Challenge tournament on Tuesday Oct. 13 will begin with the Johnny Miller and Friends Golf Clinic featuring five-time World Long Drive Champion Jason Zuback. The clinic is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. at The Thanksgiving Point driving range, followed by the tournament at 10:00 a.m.
